This document outlines the implementation process, data requirements, timeline, and reporting structure for OpioidRx.

1. Program Overview

OpioidRx is an evidence-based opioid prevention program that identifies early prescribing risk patterns using de-identified pharmacy claims.

The program operates in three structured phases:

- 1 Baseline Risk Analysis**
- 2 Prescriber Engagement**
- 3 Ongoing Monitoring and Reporting**

No system integration is required.

No disruption to your existing health plan.

No patient health information is collected.

2. Implementation Timeline

TIMEFRAME	MILESTONE
Weeks 1–2	Data intake and validation
Weeks 3–4	Baseline analysis and executive reporting
Month 2	Provider engagement begins
Month 3	First progress update delivered
Ongoing	Quarterly monitoring and structured reporting

Implementation is structured, predictable, and designed to minimize administrative effort.

3. Data Requirements

OpioidRx analyzes paid pharmacy claims using blinded member identifiers. We require a limited data set, including:

- De-identified member ID
- National Drug Code (NDC)
- Fill dates
- Quantity
- Days supply
- Prescriber identifier
- Paid amount
- **No names**
- **No social security numbers**
- **No addresses**
- **No personal health information**

Secure encrypted file transfer is provided.

Our technical team works directly with your designated data contact.

4. Baseline Risk Report

Within approximately 30 days of receiving validated data, you will receive a structured baseline report that includes:

- Number of members exposed to opioid risk
- Prescribing pattern distribution
- Provider prescribing profiles
- Estimated cost impact
- Reduction opportunity analysis

This report establishes your measurable starting point.

5. Provider Engagement Process

Licensed clinical pharmacists conduct structured outreach to providers identified through prescribing profile analysis.

THE OUTREACH PROCESS IS

- Educational
- Evidence-based
- CDC-aligned
- Non-accusatory
- Documentation-focused

The objective is to support appropriate tapering or transition decisions when clinically indicated.

Historically, 95–99% of contacted providers adopt recommended documentation improvements.

Your organization is not required to participate in these conversations.

OpioidRx manages the engagement process.

6. Ongoing Monitoring & Reporting

You will receive quarterly performance reports that include:

- Reduction in high-risk opioid prescriptions
- Prescribing pattern improvements
- Healthcare encounter trends
- Cost impact analysis
- Provider adoption metrics

Reports are structured for executive leadership and board-level review.

All metrics are derived from blinded claims data.

7. Roles and Responsibilities

- Provide claims data via secure transfer
- Designate a primary contact
- Review quarterly reports

OPIOIDRX

- Data analysis
- Prescriber identification
- Pharmacist outreach
- Monitoring and documentation
- Executive reporting

- No patient health information is collected
- All data is de-identified
- Secure encrypted transfer protocols are used
- No prescription access restrictions are imposed
- Physicians retain full clinical autonomy

- Reductions in high-risk opioid prescribing
